

ATTENTION:

Please be advised these are sample ballots and because the law requires rotation of the candidates' names on the ballots, the chronological order as listed may be different in your precinct.

ALSO:

Because some listed candidates are elected in specific districts, some names listed in these Sample Ballots may not appear on the ballot in your precinct. Special Election Question(s) or Bond Proposition(s) are also voted on in specific districts so may not appear on the ballot in your precinct.

Notice to All Voters:

Pursuant to 32-811(1) several races for nonpartisan offices will not appear on the Primary ballot as the number of candidates did not exceed twice the number of vacancies – these candidates are declared nominated and will auto-advance to the General Election.

Also – County partisan races which a candidate is unopposed for their party's nomination – are declared nominated and will auto-advance to the General Election.

Notice to Nonpartisan Voters:


A registered voter who is not affiliated with a political party and who desires to vote in the primary election – may request a nonpartisan party ballot for the offices of United States Senator and United States House of Representative for any one of the three state recognized political parties per 32-912(3).

In addition, this year the Nebraska Democratic Party has opened their primary election per 32-912(2) to allow nonpartisan voters to vote in any race where their party is nominating a candidate for a partisan office.

No such registered nonpartisan voter shall receive more than one such described partisan ballot.

None of the additional revenues collected from increasing the sales and use tax rate will be used for purposes of the interlocal agreement.</p>

Savings and efficiencies will be realized through economic development brought about by improvements through such public infrastructure project.</p>	<p>Years within which the revenue will be collected; payment of bonds: The increase in the sales and use tax shall terminate no more than ten years after the effective date of the increased sales and use tax or, if bonds are issued and the local option sales and use tax revenue is pledged for payment of such bonds, upon payment of such bonds and any refunding bonds, whichever date is later, provided that the portion of the rate greater than one and one-half percent imposed for the purpose of the interlocal agreement between the City of Ashland and the Ashland-Greenwood Public Schools Saunders County School District 78-0001, which interlocal agreement is related to public infrastructure projects, shall not terminate.</p> <p>Interlocal Agreement: The City of Ashland and the Ashland-Greenwood Public Schools Saunders County School District 78-0001 have entered into an interlocal agreement that created a separate administrative entity for purposes of the agreement, related to public infrastructure projects.
