

**NOTICE OF RECALL ELECTION**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that pursuant to a petition filed in the Office of the Saunders County Clerk, a Recall Election will be held in Saunders County on Tuesday, December 14, 2021, by an "ALL MAIL ELECTION", at which time there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the Saunders County Board of Supervisors District 2 the following question:

"Shall Doris M. Karloff be removed from the office of the Saunders County Board of Supervisors District 2?"

Electors wishing to vote in favor of the recall shall darken the oval to the left of the word "yes" and electors wishing to vote against the recall shall darken the oval to the left of the word "no".

**By-Mail Election** – This election will be an "**All Mail Election**". All registered voters residing within the boundaries of the Saunders County Board of Supervisors District 2 will receive their ballot by mail at their address as it appears on the voter registration register and therefore no polling place will be open for voting. Ballots will be mailed by the Saunders County Clerk, between November 22, 2021 and December 3, 2021.

**Voter Registration Deadlines –**

1. **November 29<sup>th</sup>** – is the last day for postmark mail in registrations, Online registrations, DMV office, deputy registrar registrations, delivered registrations by individuals other than the voter themselves and agency registrations (**3<sup>rd</sup> Friday prior**)
2. **December 3<sup>rd</sup>** – is the last day for in person voter registration in the office of the Election Commissioner or County Clerk (**6:00 p.m. 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday prior**)

**Voters that will be absent** – Registered Voters who will be absent from their residence may complete an "Application for Early Voter's Ballot" – that is posted with this notice.

**Applications will be accepted until November 22, 2021**

The **ExpressVote voting system** will be available to provide ADA accessibility for the Saunders County Board of Supervisors District 2 voters to use – please call the Saunders County Clerk's office at 402-443-8101 to make arrangements to use the ExpressVote voting system.

**Ballot Return Deadline** - Voted ballots that are sealed in the "Return Identification Envelope" may be returned by one of the following means:

1. By US Mail – place **58¢** postage on the envelope to mail the ballot back.
2. Hand Deliver – the ballot to the Saunders County Clerk's office, 433 N. Chestnut, Courthouse, 3rd Floor, Suite 300, Wahoo.
3. Place the ballot in the Drop-off Deposit Box that is located just outside the North Entrance of the Courthouse.

**NOTE: ALL ballots must be in the possession of the Saunders County Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on Election Day, December 14, 2021.**
