



Have you ever wanted to work in a field that is challenging, rewarding, meaningful, and exciting? The Saunders County Sheriff's Office is hiring for the position of 911 Dispatcher. Emergency dispatch personnel fulfill a vital first responder role by being the first to speak with someone when they call 911 in an emergency. Skills to be successful in this job include, being able to multi-task very well, be a good listener, and yet have compassion to be able to control dynamic situations in times of an emergency.

Dispatchers have a variety of duties, such as the following:

- Answer both 911 and non-emergency calls for service
- Use computers and computer-aided dispatch
- Dispatch and monitor fire departments, rescue and law enforcement

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must be a citizen of the United States; be at least 19 years of age or older; possess a high school diploma or equivalent; be of good moral character with no felony or serious misdemeanor convictions; and within one year obtain necessary certifications. Applicants may be required to pass a drug test. Must be a team player and be able to work all shifts, weekends, and holidays, as needed.

Starting Salary: \$16.76 per hour with a **\$3,000.00 hiring bonus paid out over two years.** Currently, dispatchers are working 12-hour shifts with every other weekend off. With this schedule, dispatchers only work 15 days per month!
