All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public, except when in closed executive session.

Chairman Lutton called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. informed the public of the location of the posting of the Open Meetings Act & Title VI Policy Statement are posted on the North wall (right hand side) as you enter the Board Room).

Public Works Director reported on the following:

- ~Dirt Crew Hauling dirt & rock from Yutan Solar farm to yards in Wahoo & Morse Bluff patrol shed, getting the rock & dirt for free. Will be mobilizing to the new tower sites to construct driveways and leveling sites for radio towers
- ~Culvert Crew Will be moving to Project 848 County Road 13&14&E Twin 84"x46' CMP with steel headwalls on 20° skew LHB. Project 877 County Road 18&e&F Triple 108"x56' 20° skew LHB CMP with headwalls is being delivered this week
