

**BOARD OF EQUALIZATION
EMERGENCY CALLED MEETING
PROCEEDINGS
July 23, 2026**

Pursuant to adjournment Sine Die and per §84-1411(4&5) an emergency meeting was called, the Board met with Tom Hrdlicka, John Zaugg, Robert Thiessen and Bill Reece present for a quorum.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance by publishing on the website and emailing to Cities and Villages and posted 3 places in the Courthouse. Notice of the meeting was emailed to members of the Board and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and agenda is attached. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Chairman Reece called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. and informed the public of the location of the posting of the Open Meetings Act & Title VI Policy Statement are posted on the North wall (right hand side) as you enter the Board Room.

Chairman Reece also stated that this emergency called meeting was for a protest that was missed and not acted on at the July 21, 2026 meeting and per §77-1502 protests must be acted on July 25th or sooner.

The County Assessor explained to the Board why this protest was missed and the reasoning for her recommendation.

Motion by Hrdlicka, seconded by Thiessen to take final action on Protest #218-2026 as recommended by the County Assessor. Voting yes were Hrdlicka, Zaugg, Thiessen and Reece. Voting no were none. Motion carried.

The proceedings of the foregoing meeting were recorded and are on file in the County Clerk's office. All items considered by the Board of Equalization were included in the agenda published or posted prior to said meeting.
