PROPOSAL TO INCREASE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX RATE
TO FUND WELLNESS AND AQUATIC CENTER
AND SPORTS FIELDS PROJECTS**

Shall the governing body of the incorporated municipality - the City of Ashland - increase the local sales and use tax rate by an additional one-half of one percent ($\frac{1}{2}\%$) from the current rate of one and one-half percent ($1\frac{1}{2}\%$) to a rate of two percent (2%) and impose a sales and use tax at the increased rate upon the same transactions within such municipality on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax?

A "Yes" Vote: If a majority of the votes cast upon such question shall be in favor of increasing such local sales and use tax rate by an additional one-half of one percent ($\frac{1}{2}\%$) to a rate of two percent (2%), then the governing body of such incorporated municipality - the City of Ashland - shall be empowered as provided by Section 77-27,142 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes and shall forthwith proceed to increase the local sales and use tax rate from one and one-half percent ($1\frac{1}{2}\%$) to two percent (2%), impose a sales and use tax at the increased rate upon the same transactions within such municipality on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax pursuant to the Local Option Revenue Act, and use the revenues from the increased tax to pay the costs of constructing a wellness and aquatic center in the City and to pay the costs of improvements to the existing sports fields in the City.

A "No" Vote: If a majority of those voting on the question shall be opposed to such an increase of the local sales and use tax rate by an additional one-half of one percent ($\frac{1}{2}\%$), then the governing body of the incorporated municipality - the City of Ashland - shall not impose such a tax increase and the local sales and use tax rate will remain unchanged at one and one-half percent ($1\frac{1}{2}\%$).

Additional Information Regarding Proposed Local Sales and Use Tax Rate Increase:

List of reductions or elimination of other taxes or fees, if any: There is not contemplated at this time to be any elimination of other taxes or fees should a majority of those voting on such question be in favor of increasing the local sales and use tax rate.

Projects to be funded, in whole or in part, from the revenue collected, along with any savings or efficiencies resulting from the projects: Pursuant to the Local Option Revenue Act, revenues from the increase in the tax from one and one-half percent ($1\frac{1}{2}\%$) to two percent (2%) are to be used for public infrastructure projects. The City has determined that all of the increase will be designated for purposes of an interlocal agreement so that the revenues will be available to fund debt service on bonds issued to pay the costs of constructing a wellness and aquatic center in and for the City and to pay the costs of improvements to the existing sports fields in and for the City. These improvements will be used and operated pursuant to an interlocal agreement between the City and Saunders County School District 0001 (Ashland-Greenwood Public Schools).

Years within which the revenue will be collected; payment of bonds: The increase in the sales and use tax will terminate upon the later of ten years after the effective date of the increased sales and use tax or, if bonds are issued and the local option sales and use tax revenue is pledged for payment of such bonds, upon payment of such bonds and any refunding bonds. The City anticipates that bonds will be issued to fund the projects and that the terms of those bonds will require the City to utilize the revenues from the increase in sales and use tax for a period of twenty-five (25) years.

Interlocal Agreement: The City of Ashland and Saunders County School District 0001 (Ashland-Greenwood Public Schools) have entered into an interlocal agreement that creates a separate administrative entity for purposes of the agreement. The interlocal agreement provides for the construction and operation of a wellness and aquatic center in and for the City and for the improvement and operation of existing sports fields in and for the City. All of these improvements will be used by the City and Saunders County School District 0001 (Ashland-Greenwood Public Schools). Such interlocal agreement contains provisions relating to the long-term development of unified governance of the wellness and aquatic center project and the sports fields.

CITY OF WAHOO CONTINUATION OF SALES TAX

Shall the City Council of the City of Wahoo, Nebraska continue to impose the existing sales and use tax of one-half percent (0.5%) upon the same transactions within the City on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax, with all revenues generated by continuation of the one-half percent (0.5%) to be used for public infrastructure projects of the City under the following terms and conditions?

Use of 0.5% Sales Tax. Revenues from continuation of the 0.5% sales and use tax are to be used for public infrastructure projects of the City as described in and permitted by the Local Option Revenue Act (the "Projects"). The Projects may include such infrastructure improvements determined to be necessary or appropriate by the City Council from time to time. If the City identifies appropriate funding sources in addition to continuation of such sales and use tax, the City intends for the Projects to include development and construction of a new civic center facility of the City (the "Civic Center") with features that could include programing and activity spaces supporting community recreation, health and wellness, aquatic activities, youth programs, and related administrative functions; as well as gymnasium and court space, fitness and wellness areas, an indoor pool, youth program space, group fitness rooms, a walking track, locker rooms, administrative offices, and related improvements, furnishings, equipment, and site work as may be necessary or appropriate for the facility.

Interlocal Agreement. The City and Saunders County have entered into an Interlocal Agreement which creates the Wahoo Civic Center Advisory Committee for purposes related to the proposed Civic Center. The Interlocal Agreement contains provisions, including benchmarks, relating to the long-term development of unified governance of a Civic Center. None of the revenue from continuation of such 0.5% sales and use tax will be transferred to the Wahoo Civic Center Advisory Committee, but shall be used by the City for such purposes determined appropriate by City Council.

Term and Expiration of 0.5% Sales Tax. The 0.5% sales and use tax shall commence upon termination of the existing 0.5% sales and use tax approved by the qualified electors of the City at the election held on May 15, 2018, which is scheduled to expire on January 1, 2029, and shall terminate no more than ten years after the effective date of the 0.5% sales and use tax or, if bonds are issued and the local option sales and use tax revenue is pledged for payment of such bonds, upon payment of such bonds and any refunding bonds, whichever date is later.
